2021 Annual Report

2021 was a challenging year for the Animal Shelter and its staff as it has been for us all. I believe the way we have met these challenges and replaced them with many accomplishments has shown that our team is truly ready for the future and anything we may face. We have continued to make many beneficial changes which will benefit both the citizens and animals of our great county which allowing our staff to meet these challenges safely. This year's successes have allowed us to exceed all we achieved in 2020. We applied and were awarded a 3,500.00 Spay Neuter grant. We re-Applied and were accepted back into a pet food donation program with Atlanta Humane society. Which secured a food supply to the shelter at no cost. We are forming many new relationships and strengthened old ones, cut euthanasia rates again this time to 18%, maintained our high adoptions rate, increased or return to owners, and animal transfers allowing our shelter to maintain a strong community involvement as well as a superior reputation. As a team we will continue to pushing forward with improvements and new Ideas.

We continue to enjoy a superior working relationship with other state and county agencies. We will continue to work as a Team streamlining the citation and code enforcement processes, insuring a consistent and fair fee structure and reporting method. These improved relationships have also earned trust and understanding for the quality of our work and investigations. We have also, over the past year, formed many new relationships with rescue groups, humane societies and area veterinarians, allowing us to continue increasing our transfer rates and decrease our euthanasia rates. In addition, we have implemented important changes to our county code of ordinance which has given us a greater ability to serve our citizens and ensure compliance in regards owner responsibilities and livestock issues. As a highlight to our year, we were asked by Fannin County Animal Services to assist them with the development of their new department's operational practices in an effort to duplicate our successes as they move forward.

We will continue to building on these successes in 2022.

Inspection Comments

Routine Inspection: Upon arrival director, Wayne Marshall, was onsite. This is a GDA licensed shelter; license appears to be current through 1-31-2022.

Upon today's inspection I observed 10 canines and 29 felines onsite.

Premise and enclosures appear to be clean and in good repair; observed employees actively cleaning throughout inspection. Facility appears to have adequate lighting, ventilation, and temperature control. Facility appears to have multiple functional fire extinguishers throughout premise. Animals onsite appear to have sufficient space provided. Interior surfaces appear to be impervious to moisture. Waste appears to be disposed of correctly. Enclosures appear to provide animals with adequate shelter from the elements. I did not observe pest control issues upon inspection. Facility appears to have adequate drainage. Animals onsite appear to be receiving adequate food and water. Food and supplies appear to be stored in an adequate manner. Animals appear to be separated by species, age, and health status. Animals appear to be being adopted out at the correct age per records. Records appear to be correct and in manageable order; facility is up to date on data reporting. Euthanasia appears to be kept under double lock and key; euthanasia records appear to be correct and in manageable order. Humane care observed. Evacuation plan posted.

Lumpkin Co Animal Shelter appears to be in compliance with the GDA rules and regulations at this time. Facility passes today's routine inspection; no violations issued.
