Lumpkin County Library Monthly Report – February 2011

Highlights:

Youth Services:

- Winter Story Time Programs concluded with a combined attendance of 65 children and 67 adults.
- Youth Services Specialist Teresa Moore conducted a story time at Lumpkin County Head Start, reaching more than 100 students.

Adult Services:

- Genealogy workshops conducted by volunteer William Knight continue to be popular. Nine people attended the February session.
- Herman and Kathy Trader, members of the Paranormal Science Investigation Network, presented a Ghost Hunter program to more than 30 attendees.
- Information Specialist Angela Glowcheski offered 3 free computer classes, all of which were filled to capacity.
- Information Specialist Angela Glowcheski assisted library patrons with 688 reference questions.

Circulation:

- Tracey Thomaswick was promoted from Circulation Specialist to Branch Manager.
- The circulation department processed 1,294 requests for materials for Lumpkin County Library patrons.
- Due to an agreement between Georgia Public Library Services and Zoo Atlanta, a Zoo pass program was launched this month that allows patrons to check out an informative Zoo Atlanta DVD, return it, and receive a pass for 2 adult and 2 child admissions to the zoo.
- Lumpkin County also has three Georgia State Park ParkPasses and Historic Site Passes. The passes are good for free parking or admission at any of the 63 parks and historic sites statewide for up to five days.
