**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Raber called the special called work session to order at 4:36 p.m. in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Boardroom of the Lumpkin County Administration Building. Present were John Raber, Bill Scott, Tim Bowden and Clarence Grindle. Clarence Stowers was absent.

**ENOTAH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**


Chairman Raber turned the meeting over to County Attorney K.C. Horne. Mr. Horne reviewed an open meetings complaint of events alleged to have occurred during an Enotah Judicial Circuit budget in April (hosted by White County, Circuit Administrator). This meeting took place in White County and was attended by representatives of White, Union, Lumpkin and Towns Counties. He explained that, according to all guidelines, they were compliant and an AG open meetings request for information was being processed at this time. Mr. Horne said that materials will be turned over to the Attorney General's office on Friday, July 8 or Monday, July 11. Mr. Horne's recommendation was to allow the process to continue because the meeting had been conducted correctly.

There was discussion of what the rules and procedures were and who had been present at the meeting. Judge Barrett said his recollection was that he was asked to leave after the report on the budget was given. Judge Bruce agreed with Judge Barrett's recollection. Mr. Horne said that the absence of minutes was reported and would be addressed. Sharon Hall, from the Dahlonega Nugget, questioned the Board individually of their recollection of events concerning whether a vote was taken at that meeting. Commissioner Scott and Commissioner Bowden agreed that they did believe there had been a vote. Chairman Raber and Commissioner Grindle responded that they did not recall there being a vote taken. There was the discussion about the contents of an open records request made by Mr. F. Earl Wiggers and the amount of time required to complete this request.


**ADJOURN**
