CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Raber called the Special Called Work Session to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Main Conference Room of the Lumpkin County Administration Building. Present were John Raber, Tim Bowden, Clarence Stowers, and Clarence Grindle. Bill Scott arrived at 5:45 p.m.

2014 SPLOST CALL FOR REFERENDUM

The purpose of this work session is to discuss the 2014 SPLOST Call for Referendum. County Manager Stan Kelley began by requesting the Board's opinion of the proposed language in the SPLOST resolution and ballot. He wanted to confirm that the wording was as they had intended. Commissioner Bowden questioned the wording regarding the Animal Shelter and Park & Recreation. Mr. Kelley clarified the items in question. There was then discussion on the General Obligation debt section. Commissioner Stowers said he was concerned that citizens would not understand that this is not more debt but rather something inserted only as a precaution.


There needs to be clarification on what each item is and why it is on there so they know how good this is and what they are voting on. Mr. Kelley reiterated that this plan is for the next ten years and they need to plan accordingly. There was discussion on rearranging the items on the list and changing the wording of "Street" to "Roads and Bridges". Commissioner Stowers will meet with the County Attorney if clarification is needed further regarding this change.

Chairman Raber asked if the Board would like to meet with the group promoting the reservoir in the southern end of Lumpkin County. It was concluded that the Board will meet with this group if there is enough time to advertise at least one week in advance of the event and if public comment is allowed at the end of the meeting.

The Chairman said he would also like to send letters of appreciation to the state employees that are working on the Lumpkin County roads. He then reminded the commissioners of the Special Called Work Session on October 18, 2011 at 5:40 p.m.
