Lumpkin County Library Monthly Report – October 2010

Highlights:

- Sarah McGhee visited Blackburn Elementary School 5th grade class as a mystery reader.
- Information Specialist Angela Glowcheski offered computer instruction three times this month.
- The October Library Book Sale generated more than \$400.
- The circulation department filled requests for 1,432 items for patrons in the community and 501 requests for materials for other libraries within the PINES system.
- Youth Services Specialist Teresa Moore offered 9 story time programs and a pumpkin decorating workshop: 80 children and 74 adults attended.
