

LUMPKIN COUNTY RESOLUTION No. 2009-05

A RESOLUTION TO DISSOLVE THE COMMUNITY HOUSE BOARD OF CONTROL

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County, recognizes that the Community House Board of Control has acted in the public purpose of managing the Lumpkin County Community House since 1941; and,


Whereas, the current serving members of said Board have turned over all operating funds to the Lumpkin County Finance Department; and,

Whereas, it appears appropriate at this time to transfer all management, maintenance and operational control to the Lumpkin County Park and Receptions Department;

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved as follows:


- a. Title to the Community House shall remain unchanged, and the owner shall continue to be Lumpkin County.
- b. The Board of Control of the Community House shall no longer be responsible for the management, operations and maintenance of the Community House. Present members of the Board of Control, in recognition of their faithful stewardship and public service, shall continue as members of the Honorary Board of Control. Upon the resignation or death of the last present member, the Board of Control shall be dissolved.
- c. The Lumpkin County Park and Recreation Department shall exercise any necessary management, maintenance and operational control of the facility. Use of the facility shall be as determined appropriate by the Park and Recreation Department.

Resolved, adopted and effective this 22nd day of January, 2009.
