A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE REQUEST OF THE TAX COMMISSIONER OF LUMPKIN COUNTY TO DELETE CERTAIN EXPIRED AND DELINQUENT TAXES FOR NON-HOMESTEAD MOBILE HOMES FROM THE CURRENT ACCOUNTS, ALL AS PROVIDED BY LAW


Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County has received a request from the Lumpkin County Tax Commissioner for approval of removing uncollectible tax accounts for unpaid taxes outside the statute of limitations for the collection of such accounts (being those taxes for non-homestead mobile homes coming due and payable in the tax years 2005 and prior; and,

Whereas, the Tax Commissioner has appeared before the Board of Commissioners and reviewed such accounts, and,

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County has considered the now uncollectible status of the accounts, and desires to approve the request.


Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the accounts determined by the Tax Commissioner of Lumpkin County to be unenforceable and uncollectible in 2009 due to the Georgia statute of limitations on such matters may be purged from the roll of delinquent taxes.
