

**Lumpkin County Resolution No. 2009-63**

**A Resolution to Amend Resolutions Imposing a Wireless Enhanced 9-1-1 Charge on Wireless Telecommunications Connections Within Lumpkin County, Georgia.**

**Whereas**, on August 4, 1997, the Commissioner of Lumpkin County imposed a 911 charge as provided by law for operations of a 911 center for Lumpkin County; and,

**Whereas**, on May 17, 2001, by Resolution 2001-26 the Commissioners of Lumpkin County, Georgia, adopted an amending resolution imposing a wireless enhanced 911 charge on wireless telecommunications with billing addresses within Lumpkin County, Georgia; and,

**Whereas**, since the adoption of such resolution Lumpkin County has enhanced and improved its 911 system so that it is now capable of providing and does provide automatic number identification and automatic location identification of a wireless telecommunications connection know as Phase II Wireless 911; and,

**Whereas**, Part 4 of Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated authorizes local governments to impose a wireless enhanced 911 charge for Phase II Service upon each wireless telecommunications connection subscribed to by subscribers whose billing address is within the jurisdiction of the local government; and,

**Whereas**, under the provisions of such law a charge for Phase II Service may be imposed at a rate of up to \$1.50 per month per wireless connection; and,


**Whereas**, a public hearing was held on October 14, 2009, on the question of amending the May 17, 2001, Resolution for the purpose of increasing the wireless enhanced 911 charge to reflect the change from Phase I Service to Phase II Service effective on October 14, 2009;

**Now therefore, it is hereby resolved** that the May 17, 2001, resolution be amended and that the wireless enhanced 911 charge imposed upon each wireless telecommunications connection subscribed to by subscribers whose billing address is within the jurisdiction of Lumpkin County, Georgia be increased up to a maximum of \$1.50 per month per wireless connection provided to each telephone subscriber.


**Be it further resolved** that said wireless charge shall be imposed beginning November 1, 2009.

**Be it further resolved** that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to each wireless service supplier providing services in Lumpkin County, Georgia.
