

LUMPKIN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2009-81

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT ADDITIONAL
RIGHT OF WAY ALONG
EAGLE REST ROAD
ADJACENT TO DEER HAVEN SUBDIVISION**

Whereas, the subdivision regulations of Lumpkin County require that developers dedicate additional right of way on existing county roads when developing on a county road with less than sixty feet of right of way; and


Whereas, Deer Haven Subdivision, a Class 2 Subdivision, located on Eagle Rest Road received final approval from the Lumpkin County Planning Commission on December 14, 2006; and

Whereas, the developers of Deer Haven Subdivision have signed a Right of Way Deed to Lumpkin County for the required additional right of way along Eagle Rest Road that lies adjacent to the subdivision; and

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County now desires to accept said additional right of way as a part of Eagle Rest Road;


Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the strip of real property, being 10 feet in width, lying between the existing right of way of Eagle Rest Road and Deer Haven subdivision is adopted as additional right of way of Eagle Rest Road.
