**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION FOR A
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR IMPROVING AND INCREASING
THE SIZE OF THE LUMPKIN COUNTY SENIOR CENTER**

Whereas, Lumpkin County is duly constituted under the laws of Georgia; and,

Whereas, in every case it is the intention of the Lumpkin County Commission to develop opportunities for the health, public good and the general welfare of the Citizens of Lumpkin County and the State of Georgia; and,

Whereas, the Lumpkin County Senior Center has outgrown the current facility in Lumpkin County,

Whereas, the project will increase the health and safety of the Senior Citizens of Lumpkin County; and,

Whereas, the financing of the project through the Community Development Block Grant Program funding is critical to the health, public good and general welfare of the Senior Citizens of Lumpkin County and Georgia; and,


Whereas, the need for adequate health care is critical for the Senior Citizens of Lumpkin County and the State of Georgia; Lumpkin County pledges as a match:

Whereas, Lumpkin County is the owner of the Lumpkin County Senior Center Building with responsibilities for lease, utilities and maintenance;


Now, therefore, be it resolved, that Lumpkin County will seek Community Development Block Grant assistance from the State of Georgia as a necessary funding component for this project.
