A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND ENACT AN AMENDMENT TO THE LUMPKIN COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE OPERATION AND SUPERVISION OF THE LUMPKIN COUNTY-WIMPY AIRPORT, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES


Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County owns and operates a public airport known as the Lumpkin County-Wimpy Airport; and,

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County now desires to Amend the provisions set out in Chapter 2, Article 5, Division 7, Sections 2-485 through 2-488 inclusive, pertaining to the Lumpkin County - Wimpy Airport by replacing the existing Sections 2-485 through 2-488 inclusive, with the revised Sections 2-485 through 2-488 inclusive, as set out on the attached Exhibit "A," which is by reference fully incorporated herein;

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the Code of Ordinances of Lumpkin County, Georgia, is hereby amended by replacing the existing Sections 2-485 through 2-488 inclusive, with the revised Sections 2-485 through 2-488 inclusive, as set out on the attached Exhibit "A," which is by reference fully incorporated herein;


It is further resolved that all prior acts and resolutions are hereby repealed.

DIVISION 7. AIRPORT COMMITTEE

Sec. 2-485. Established.

The county has established, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 6-3-25, the Lumpkin County Airport Committee. The committee shall be a county body, under the supervision of the board of county commissioners and shall not operate as a separate legal entity or authority.

Sec. 2-486. Members; appointment; terms.

The airport committee shall consist of five members appointed by the board of commissioners of the county, which members shall serve at the discretion of the board of commissioners for staggered terms of three years. The members shall at the first meeting each year elect from their members a chairman who may serve no more than one term as chairman during a single three year term.

Sec. 2-487. Minutes.

The airport committee shall keep minutes of all meetings and provide copies of the same to the board of commissioners no less than monthly. Notice of an agenda for all meetings shall be provided to the county clerk not less than five days prior to the scheduled meeting. Any emergency meeting shall require immediate notification and justification transmitted by telephone or e-mail to the county clerk and county manager prior to the meeting. Issues not included on the agenda for a meeting shall not be presented or voted on; any vote on a matter not specified in the agenda as provided to the county clerk shall be a nullity.

Sec. 2-488. Duties and authority.

- (a) The airport committee shall recommend for adoption by the county commissioners such regulations and charges or fees for the use of the airport as the committee may determine to be necessary or appropriate.

(b) The airport committee may make recommendations to the county commissioners on matters pertaining to airport operations, including but not limited to,

(1) The sale of aviation fuel.

(2) The assignment of hangar and tie-down space.

(3) Maintenance of runway, apron area, lights, navigational aids, hangars, equipment and all other public improvements and facilities.

(c) The airport committee may assign or lease to private parties space, facilities, or equipment on such airport, provided that in so doing all leases comport with the laws of Georgia for county owned and county operated airports for the benefit of the public so that the public is not deprived of its rightful, equal and uniform use of the airport.
