**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE 2011 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE
FOR
LUMPKIN COUNTY GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS**


Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County desires to designate and set out those days which shall be accounted for as "holidays" during the 2011 calendar year;

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved:

- a. December 31, 2010, shall be observed as January 1, 2011 New Year's Day.
- b. January 17, 2011, shall be observed as Martin Luther King Day.
- c. May 30, 2011, shall be observed as Memorial Day.
- d. July 4, 2011, shall be observed as Independence Day.
- e. September 5, 2011, shall be observed as Labor Day.
- f. November 11, 2011, shall be observed as Veteran's Day (it further being the decision of the Board that Veteran's Day shall each year be observed on November 11, the calendar date, and no other day shall be substituted. If the date falls on Saturday or Sunday, the day will not be observed as a Holiday).
- g. November 24, 2011, shall be observed as Thanksgiving Day and November 25, 2011, shall be observed as a holiday.
- h. December 23, 2011, Friday, shall be observed as the holiday for Christmas Eve which falls on Saturday, December 24, 2011.
- i. December 26, 2011, Monday, shall be observed as the holiday for Christmas Day which falls on Sunday, December 25, 2011.

The Lumpkin County Justice Center, Lumpkin County Administration Building and other County offices other than public safety will normally be closed on holidays.

Resolved, adopted and effective this 18th day of November, 2010.
