A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE
THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF LUMPKIN COUNTY

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County has noted that the "Official Seal of Lumpkin County" now in use has become exceptionally worn and is no longer sufficient to the task; and,

Whereas, the design of said seal was simply "as acquired" and does not reflect the origin of the County or any specific point in the County's history; and,

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County now desires to approve the design of the official seal and adopt it for all official purposes for which the Official Seal of Lumpkin County is required.

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the seal set out hereon is adopted as the official seal of Lumpkin County and shall be used for the attestation and authentication of all documents or other publications for which such seals are required or for which they are routinely used.


