A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF FEES FROM THE RETAIL SALE OF TELEPHONE CARDS AND PREPAID PHONES FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE E911 CENTER


Whereas, the Legislature of the State of Georgia has by adoption of House Bill 256 amended O.C.G.A. 46-5-134.2 (*Effective January 1, 2012*) to provide for collection of certain fees from the retail sale of telephone cards and prepaid telephones; and

Whereas, said act further provides for said funds to be provided for the Emergency Telephone System Fund in those counties which have imposed fees as provided therein; and,

Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County now desires to impose such a fee or charge as is by law provided;

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the prepaid wireless 9-1-1 charge authorized by O.C.G.A. 46-5-138.2 shall be implemented in Lumpkin County, and all such funds paid over to Lumpkin County shall be expended as provided by said statute.
