LUMPKIN COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**


Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County has received notice that the draft Lumpkin County Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan has received approval from both the Georgia Emergency Management Authority (GEMA) and the Federal Emergency Management Authority (FEMA); and,

Whereas, it is necessary that said plan be formally adopted to become an official and implemented tool for management and coordination during emergencies and disasters affecting Lumpkin County and its citizens; and,

Whereas, it is further required by FEMA and GEMA that local city government also adopt said plans;


