**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE 2012 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE
FOR
LUMPKIN COUNTY GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS**


Whereas, the governing authority of Lumpkin County desires to designate and set out those days which shall be accounted for as “holidays” during the 2012 calendar year;

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved:

- a. January 2, 2012, shall be observed as New Year’s Day.
- b. January 16, 2012, shall be observed as Martin Luther King Day.
- c. May 28, 2012, shall be observed as Memorial Day.
- d. July 4, 2012, shall be observed as Independence Day.
- e. September 3, 2012, shall be observed as Labor Day.
- f. November 11, 2012, (Sunday) shall be observed as Veteran’s Day (it further being the decision of the Board that Veteran’s Day shall each year be observed on November 11, the calendar date, and no other day shall be substituted. If the date falls on Saturday or Sunday, the day will not be observed as a Holiday).
- g. November 22, 2012, shall be observed as Thanksgiving Day and November 23, 2012, shall be observed as a holiday.
- h. December 24, 2012, Monday, shall be observed as the holiday for Christmas Eve.
- i. December 25, 2012, Tuesday, shall be observed as the holiday for Christmas Day.


The Lumpkin County Courthouse and other County offices other than public safety will normally be closed on holidays.
