

**LUMPKIN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2011 – 71**

**A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE LIMITATION AND CONTROL  
OF  
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES  
AND THE  
PROVISION AND CONSUMPTION OF SUCH BEVERAGES  
ON  
LUMPKIN COUNTY PROPERTY AND IN ANY BUILDING OR FACILITY OF LUMPKIN COUNTY**

**Whereas**, the governing authority of Lumpkin County has by Resolution adopted certain provisions licensing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in Lumpkin County, said provisions be further codified in Part II, Chapter 4. Alcoholic Beverages of the Code of Ordinances of Lumpkin County Georgia; and,

**Whereas**, the Code of Ordinances makes no provision for the sale of alcoholic beverages by Private Clubs as contemplated by O.C.G.A. § 3-7-1, *et seq.*; and,

**Whereas**, the Code of Ordinances makes no provision for the sale of alcoholic beverages at Publicly Owned Facilities as contemplated by O.C.G.A. § 3-8-1, *et seq.*; and,

**Whereas**, the Code of Ordinances makes no provision for the sale of alcoholic beverages at Nonprofit Organizations as contemplated by O.C.G.A. § 3-9-1, *et seq.*; and,

**Whereas**, the Code of Ordinances makes no provision for the sale of alcoholic beverages off licensed premises at any catered function as contemplated by O.C.G.A. § 3-11-1, *et seq.*; and,


**Whereas**, there exists no formal policy for sale of alcoholic beverages at other than a licensed premise as provided in Chapter 4 of said Code of Ordinances other than the special event as provided by resolution; and,

**Whereas**, the Board of Commissioners now desire to publish a formal policy consistent with the informal policy established to prohibit the consumption of alcohol in certain County owned facilities;

**Now, therefore**, it is hereby resolved that the following policy is adopted for all buildings, facilities, and lands owned by Lumpkin County: no alcoholic beverage shall be sold, provided or consumed in any building or facility owned by Lumpkin County, nor on any real property of Lumpkin County, except as may be consumed on the premises of a duly licensed retail seller, or in accordance with a duly authorized and approved special event or festival license issued by the Georgia Department of Revenue with the concurrence of the governing authority of Lumpkin County.


**Further, therefore,** this prohibition shall not restrict nor limit the use of alcoholic beverages for training purposes by law enforcement. Such training shall be strictly under the supervision of and as directed by the Lumpkin County Sheriff or his designated supervisor.
