

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE LUMPKIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

May 19, 2015

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dockery began the meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the Boardroom of the Lumpkin County Administration Building. Present were Chris Dockery, Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen.

INVOCATION

The Fountain Pastor, Bo Robinson, gave the invocation which was followed by the pledge of allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the agenda which was seconded by Rhett Stringer. That motion was then approved by all district commissioners. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (*Agenda Specific*)

Chairman Dockery asked the public if there were any comments on agenda specific items. There were no comments at this time.

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill moved to approve the proclamation. That motion was seconded by Steve Shaw and approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer and Pullen. The motion carried.

Motion: Chairman Dockery made a nominating motion to appoint Sandra Smith to Seat 3. The motion was seconded by Steve Shaw. The motion was the approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer and Pullen. The motion carried.

Motion: A nominating motion was made by Chairman Dockery to appoint Jeffrey Bolles to Seat 5. That motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer and approved by all district commissioners. Motion carried.

Motion: A nominating motion was then made by Chairman Dockery to appoint Nancy Vollbeer to Seat 8. The motion was seconded by Doug Sherrill. Motion was approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer and Pullen. The motion carried.

2015-31 Appoint/Reappoint Member Lumpkin County Water & Sewerage Authority

CONTRACTS/AGREEMENTS

2015-027-GDOC – Inmate Work Detail Contracts 1 & 2

This is for two work details and two full-time correctional officers to perform labor on public works projects.

Motion: Commissioner Stringer moved to approve the inmate work agreement. The motion was seconded by Bob Pullen and approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.

2015-028-ACCG-GHBP Health Promotion Grants Application – Wellness Program

This agreement provides for the application of the GHBP Health Promotion Grant for the Wellness Program for the employees of Lumpkin County.

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill moved to approve the wellness program grant agreement which was seconded by Rhett Stringer. Motion was approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.

2015-029-MSI Blue Cross-Blue Shield Renewal Agreement

MSI Benefits presented the Commissioners with three options being offered by Blue Cross/Blue Shield through ACCG.

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the staff recommendation. That motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer and approved by all district commissioners. The motion carried.

Motion: Commissioner Pullen made a motion to include a surcharge for spousal insurance of \$100 a month and seconded by Chris Dockery and approved by Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. Doug Sherrill was opposed. The motion carried.

2015-030-Cooperative Law Enforcement Annual Operating & Financial Plan – LCSO & USDA, Forest Service

This is for approval of an agreement to document a cooperative effort between the parties to enhance State and local law enforcement in connection with activities on U.S. National Forest Service lands and provide for reimbursement to Lumpkin County for the intensified portion of this effort.

Motion: Commissioner Dockery moved to approve the Annual Operating and Financial Plan. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer. Motion was approved by all district commissioners. Motion carried.

2015-031-Physio Control, Inc. – LIFEPAK Transmission

This renewal agreement is for the Physio Control, Inc. – LIFEPAK Transmission contract.

Motion: A motion was made by Commissioner Stringer approve the Physio Control, Inc. agreement. The motion was seconded by Bob Pullen and approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.

2015-032-Medical Director – Emergency Services – Dr. Jack Freeman

This annual contract provides that Dr. Jack Freeman will act as the Medical Director for Lumpkin County Emergency Services.

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the renewal agreement with Dr. Jack Freeman which was seconded by Steve Shaw. The motion was approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.

2015-033-Dog & Cat Sterilization Grant FY 2015

This is an application for a grant program that is intended to target and aid communities across Georgia by keeping strays of the street and controlling the animal population in a humane manner.

Motion: Commissioner Stringer moved to approve the grant application. The motion was seconded by Bob Pullen and approved by all district commissioners. The motion carried.

2015-034-LMIG Contract Extension to Include Seven Mile Hill Road

This is an extension of the LMIG contract to include Seven Mile Hill Road.

Motion: A motion was made by Commissioner Dockery approve the contract extension. That motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer. Motion was then approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.

2015-035-Extend Contract with Mauldin & Jenkins for Annual Audit

This is an extension to the Mauldin & Jenkins agreement allowing them to continue to do the county audit.

Motion: *Commissioner Pullen moved to approve the extended agreement which was seconded by Doug Sherrill. The motion was then approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen and the motion carried.*

OTHER ITEMS

Woman's Club Furniture Donation

This is to all a donation of furniture and accessories for the Community House Parlor by the Dahlenega Woman's Club.

Motion: *Commissioner Dockery moved to approve the furniture donation. The motion was seconded by Steve Shaw. Motion was approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.*

2015 SPLOST Work Plan – Lease Option for Sheriff's Office Vehicles

This is to approve the 2015 SPLOST Work Plan to include a lease option for the Sheriff's Office vehicles.

Motion: *Commissioner Sherrill moved to approve the Work Plan including the lease option. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer.*

Motion: *Commissioner Sherrill amended his motion to approve the purchase of three 2015 Dodge Chargers at an amount of \$95,263.58. That motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer. Motion was approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.*

Dahlenega Car Club – Use of County Facility

The Dahlenega Car Club is requesting to expand the current 4th of July Charity Classic Car Show, being held on county owned property, to include church and for-profit vendors.

Motion: *Commissioner Dockery moved to approve including nonprofit vendors. The motion was seconded by Doug Sherrill. Motion was approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.*

Robinson Hauling – Transfer Station Fee Increase

The fees at Eagle Point Landfill were increased effective May 1, 2015 therefore, Mark Robinson Hauling has requested to increase the fees at the Lumpkin County Transfer Station, from \$41.00 to \$42.50 per ton.

Motion: *Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the Increased Fees at Eagle Point. The motion was seconded by Steve Shaw and approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.*

Election of Vice-Chairman

This is for approval of Doug Sherrill to be the Vice-Chairman of the Board of Commissioners for 2015.

Motion: *A nominating motion was made by Chairman Dockery to appoint Doug Sherrill as the Vice Chairman. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer and approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.*

COMMENTS

COUNTY MANAGER

The County Manager discussed the Frogtown Fire Station pre-bid meeting. He said there will be a Building Committee meeting at 9:00 a.m., Monday, June 8, 2015 to learn the staff's recommended bid award.

COUNTY ATTORNEY

The County Attorney had no comments.

COMMISSIONERS

- Chairman Dockery encouraged everyone's involvement in the Community Visioning Group, with suggestions on how to better benefit the community.
- Commissioner Sherrill met with a potential client, looking for property in the county, for an assisted living home.
- Commissioner Shaw reported the amount of construction permits, he had obtained by the Health Department.
- Commissioner Stringer gave a status update of the Road and Water Department projects underway.
- Commissioner Pullen updated every one on the Visioning Group progress.

Chairman Dockery listed all of the things that have been completed, at no cost to the taxpayers, in reference to fire protection and ISO ratings. He said he wanted everyone to know that the county is working as quickly as possible, the best way possible, at little to no cost to the taxpayers.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Major Mike Ramsey read aloud a message he received from Sheriff Jarrard, sharing his concern for Lumpkin County employees having an increased cost in health insurance.
