DISCUSS FIRE STATION #7 – FROGTOWN



He explained that the department has improved and gave justification of why a fire station should be placed in the Frogtown area versus other areas in the county.

There was then discussion of population coverage from the proposed station, how Chief Wimpy planned to keep the station manned, and the extent of Fire and EMS coverage from that station. Finance Director Allison Martin presented the financial portion of the presentation, showing where dedicated funds had been set aside, since the project was initially approved.
