

BIRTH CERTIFICATES

The Lumpkin County Probate Court is the Vital Records Custodian for Lumpkin County. If you were born in the State of Georgia, you can now obtain your birth certificate at the Lumpkin County Probate Court; provided that we are able to access it on the state system.

A birth certificate is a confidential document, and only the individual, biological or adoptive parents, biological or adoptive grandparents, legal guardian, adult child, or spouse can obtain a birth certificate. To obtain a birth certificate you must present a valid, government issued picture I.D. (driver's license, military I.D., state issued I.D.).

Fees - Certified Birth Certificates

\$25.00 for the first certified copy and \$5.00 for each additional certified copy - **PER PERSON**

Payment can be in the form of cash, personal check, or money order only. No credit/debit cards are accepted.

If you would like to obtain your birth certificate from Lumpkin County, you can come in person, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, except for holidays. You may also request a birth certificate by mail, by sending a written request to:

If you are requesting your birth certificate through the mail you need to include the following information: Full name of the child, mother's maiden name, father's name, and child's date of birth, along with the address that you wish for the birth certificate to be mailed to. You must include your check or money order made payable to Probate Court.
