DOMESTIC RELATIONS ACTION STANDING ORDER


By attachment of this Order to the within and foregoing Complaint, the Plaintiff (Movant) and the Defendant (Respondent) to this action, their agents, servants, and employees and all other persons acting in concert with them, are **HEREBY RESTRAINED AND ENJOINED** as follows:


- 1) You are restrained and enjoined from unilaterally causing or permitting any minor child or children of the parties to this action to be removed from the jurisdiction of this Court without the written Order of this Court, except in any emergency which has been created by the other party to the action.
- 2) You are restrained and enjoined from doing or attempting to do or threatening to do any act which injures, maltreats, vilifies, molests or harasses, or which may, upon judicial determination, constitute threats, harassment, or stalking, of the other party to this action, or of any child or children of the parties to this action, or any act which constitutes a violation of any other civil or criminal law of this State.
- 3) Except in actions for annulment, termination of parental rights in connection within an adoption proceeding, or vacating a judgment or order concerning any domestic relations action, you are restrained and enjoined from selling, encumbering, trading, contracting to sell, or otherwise disposing of or removing from the jurisdiction of this Court, without the written permission of this Court, any of the property belonging to or claimed by any party to this action, except in the ordinary course of business or except in an emergency which has been created by the other party to this action.
- 4) You are restrained and enjoined from disconnecting the utilities for the marital home.
- 5) You are restrained and enjoined from canceling, changing or allowing a lapse of any insurance policy insuring the Plaintiff (Movant) or the Defendant (Respondent) or the minor child or children.
- 6) The parties to a domestic relations action which involves minor children must provide the Court with the Child Support Work Sheets and all appropriate Schedules. The parties are to provide such information via the Online Child Support guidelines calculator and via a printed version of the Online results.

Upon written motion by any party to this action, the within and foregoing Standing Order will be reviewed by the Court at any hearing, upon notice served upon the other party to this action as by law provided




DOMESTIC RELATIONS ACTION STANDING ORDER


It is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the Clerk of Superior Court of LUMPKIN County attach to each domestic relations action filed in the LUMPKIN County Superior Court, and to each service copy or copies thereof, a copy of the attached Domestic Relations Standing Order, so that the same will appear as an integral part of the proceeding.

It is further **ORDERED** that a domestic relations action within this Circuit for the purposes of this Order shall include any action for divorce, alimony, equitable division of assets and liabilities, child custody, child support (excluding actions filed by the Office of Child Support Recovery or under the terms and provision of URESA), legitimation, annulment, determination of paternity, termination of parental rights in connection with an adoption proceeding, any contempt proceeding relating to enforcement of a decree or order, an action on a foreign judgment based on alimony or child support and adoption. The term "domestic relations action" shall also include any direct or collateral attack on a judgment or order entered in any such action.


