

The Family Law Assistance Program provides a FREE workshop for individuals in need of legal help who do not have the ability to hire a lawyer to represent them in a traditional fashion. This workshop is designed to assist you with cases involving divorce and legitimation. While we recognize the facts of each case are individual and specific to your case, there are basic rules that all cases must comply with.

At the Family Law Workshop, an attorney will provide you with a one-hour presentation that covers basic topics in your family law case. The attorney will then be available for a broad question and answer session following the presentation. The attorney will only be able to answer general questions during this question and answer session. At the conclusion of the workshop, participants will be able to purchase packets of forms and instructions on how to begin his or her case. The attorneys will provide a list of other attorneys who are willing to provide assistance to potential clients in a limited scope-

- ❖ What mandatory forms do I need to file my case?
- ❖ How do I get to court?
- ❖ What is required of me before I get to court?
