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## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

This Grand Jury would like to make the following recommendations:

Jail upgrades as follows:

- Eight (8) cells need rebar.
- A pole is needed at the bottom of the fence for security.
- Razor wire is needed for the yard and impound lot.
- Security glass is needed on all windows.
- Additional Staff is needed.
- Additional Taser guns are needed so the entire staff is certified and have Tasers.

County Commissioners and County Manager authorize necessary funding for repairs at the detention center.

County Commissioners and County Manager authorize necessary funding for the hiring of additional staffing for the detention center.

An inspection of the offices and operation of the following offices were conducted by the Grand Jury pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-12-71(b)(1):


Lumpkin County Detention Center


The Grand Jury inspected the Lumpkin County Detention Center and was given a tour of the facility and everything was found to be in order.


