Questions and Answers

Why is a Fire Engine dispatched to a Motor Vehicle Accident, with the Ambulance?

The Paramedics on the ambulance will assist the injured persons while the firefighters on the fire engine will look for hazards, such as fuel leaks. They may be needed to disconnect batteries and disable airbags, and/or assist with traffic control.

Why is there more than one Apparatus dispatched to a Medical Call?

Some medical calls require more than just the 2 Paramedics that ride in the ambulance. Depending on the severity of the illness or injury, more team members may be requested or cancelled. In some areas of the county our Volunteer First Responders will arrive in their personal vehicle to assist ambulance personnel.
