APPLY FOR AND, IF APPROVED, ACCEPT, A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
FOR
WATER LINE IMPROVEMENTS AND FACILITIES FOR STORM WATER CONTROL**

WHEREAS, the County of Lumpkin is duly constituted under the laws of Georgia;
and,

WHEREAS, in every case it is the intention of the County of Lumpkin to develop opportunities for the public good and the general welfare of the citizens of Lumpkin County and the State of Georgia; and,


WHEREAS, the proposed water line improvement project will provide residents within the Target Area adequate facilities for storm water carry off.

WHEREAS, the project will benefit at a minimum 70% low to moderate-income persons; and,

WHEREAS, the financing of the project through the Community Development Block Grant funding is critical to adequately addressing the needs of Lumpkin County residents; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that Lumpkin County will seek Community Development Block Grant assistance from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs as a necessary funding component for this project.
