**A RESOLUTION TO DISSOLVE THE CONCEPT COMMITTEE
FOR THE
MCDONALD HOUSE AREA OF YAHoola CREEK PARK**


Whereas, the Board of Commissioners by Resolution 2012-27, adopted May 15, 2012, provided for a study committee, to evaluate the McDonald House area of the Yahoola Creek Park, to determine the purpose and needs of such an area, to determine funding requirements and to consider funding sources; and

Whereas, said committee was sometimes informally referred to as “the Lumpkin County Living History Committee,” and more formally as the “Concept Committee” as set out above; and,

Whereas, said committee was active in 2012, but has provided no minutes nor other indications of activity since the August 16, 2012, report.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Concept Committee created by Resolution 2012-27 is dissolved as a Lumpkin County governmental committee or organization.
