

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE LUMPKIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

March 15, 2016

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dockery began the meeting at 6:07 p.m. in the Boardroom of the Lumpkin County Administration Building. Present were Chris Dockery, Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen.

INVOCATION

Sheriff Stacy Jarrard gave the invocation which was followed by the pledge of allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the agenda. This motion was seconded by Steve Shaw and approved by all district commissioners and the motion carried.

2016-010-LCWSA – LC Environmental Facilities Agreement

This is an agreement for a Community Development Block Grant for water line improvements and facilities for storm water control.

***Motion:** Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the environmental facilities agreement. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer and approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.*

2016-011-SAFER Grant Application

This is to prepare and submit a FY-2015 SAFER grant application to fund twelve full-time firefighter positions.

***Motion:** Commissioner Stringer moved to approve the grant application. The motion was seconded by Steve Shaw.*

***Motion:** Commissioner Stringer amended his motion to approve the grant application for 2 positions. The motion was seconded by Doug Sherrill. Motion was approved by all district commissioners. The motion carried.*

2016-012-GDOT LMIG Additional Striping

This is to prepare and submit an application for DOT Off System Safety Improvements funded through the LMIG Program.

***Motion:** A motion was made by Commissioner Stringer to approve this application for funding which was seconded by Bob Pullen. The motion was then approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.*

2016-013-A, Waive Irregularity of Bid Documents

This is to waive the irregularity, clerical error, in the GDOT LMIG Paving bid documents submitted by Colditz Trucking.

***Motion:** Commissioner Pullen moved to approve waiving the irregularity. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer. Motion was approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.*

2016-013-B, Colditz Trucking – LMIG Asphalt Paving & Patching Various County Roads

This agreement allows Colditz Trucking Inc. to perform paving & patching with asphalt concrete of the county roads listed in the LMIG Project Report.

***Motion:** Commissioner Pullen made a motion to approve the agreement with Colditz Trucking. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer and approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.*

OTHER ITEMS

Connectivity Bridge, Yahoola Creek Park – Approval of Tiles

This is to allow the Leadership Lumpkin class to sell and install recognition tiles as part of their fundraising activities for the ConnectAbility Bridge Project associated with the installation of an ADA compliant playground at Yahoola Creek Park.

Motion: Commissioner Sherrill made a motion to approve the tiles. The motion was seconded by Chris Dockery and was approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. Motion carried.

2016 Work Plan for the 2014 SPLOST

This is for approval of the 2016 SPLOST Work Plan of the 2014 SPLOST.

Motion: Commissioner Stringer moved to approve the 2016 Work Plan. The motion was seconded by Bob Pullen.

Motion: Commissioner Stringer then amended his motion to remove the street lights from the Work Plan and approve. The motion was seconded by Doug Sherrill. Motion was approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen and the motion carried.

Vote on Capital Improvements Plan (C.I.P.)

This is for approval of the Capital Improvements Plan.

Motion: A motion was made by Commissioner Stringer to approve the Plan and to move the dump bed truck to 2017. The motion was seconded by Doug Sherrill and approved by all district commissioners. The motion carried.

A.D.A. Mitigation – Building Modifications Under \$20,000

This is a request for permission to expedite ADA Mitigation building modification projects that cost \$20,000 or less.

Motion: Commissioner Pullen made a motion to approve permission to expedite these projects, which was seconded by Rhett Stringer. Motion was then approved by Doug Sherrill, Steve Shaw, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. The motion carried.

Litter Committee

This is to discuss formation of a Litter Committee.

Great American Cleanup

This is to discuss whether to provide a free disposal day at the Lumpkin County Transfer Station for tires and other large items as part of the Great American Cleanup program.

Motion: Commissioner Pullen moved to approve participation in the Cleanup. The motion was seconded by Rhett Stringer and approved by all district commissioners. The motion carried.

Letter, Three Sisters – Georgia Wine Festival June 4-5, 11-12, 18-19, and 25-26, 2016

This letter allows Three Sisters Vineyard to conduct their annual Georgia Wine Country Festival. The event will be held for five weekends: June 4 – 5, June 11 – 12, June 18 – 19, and June 25 – 26, 2016.

Motion: A motion was made by Chairman Dockery to approve the letter. The motion was then seconded by Steve Shaw and approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.

COUNTY MANAGER

The County Manager had no comments at this time.

COUNTY ATTORNEY

The County Attorney had no comments.

COMMISSIONERS

- Chairman Dockery stated that Economic Development is working with RefrigiWear in expanding.
- Commissioner Shaw confirmed what a great idea it was to form a litter committee.
- Commissioner Stringer reported that the W&S Department is set to begin work on the Camelot extension.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Gerald Lewy expressed his support for the Litter Committee.

Citizen Bill Lewis, representing the citizens of the Frogtown Community, read aloud a previously prepared letter. He brought a signed petition from the residents in that area, asking for the original planned station, not the scaled down version.

Citizen Dee Reynolds of Frank Christian Road requested that people slow down on her road. She stated that the road was not safe and their family dog was recently killed by a vehicle. She said she wants to prevent this from happening to another family.

Gaylon Robinson spoke from personal experience concerning the response time of Fire/EMS to the Frogtown area.

Greg Reynolds, citizen of Frank Christian Rd, spoke on the county litter problem and individuals who own trash pickup services.

Emily Lewy stated that there were various items thrown out along the roadway, when she picked up trash.
