V. Public Hearings: (2 Voters, Vanzyl and Eaton)

- In accordance with O.C.G.A. § 21-2-228, a hearing was held to determine the eligibility to remain on the Electors List of two individuals. A detailed list with reasons for the challenge, pertinent research and the date the notices were mailed to the individuals were reviewed by the Board. The challenged voters was not in attendance.
- Based upon the available evidence, Ms. Sorohan made a motion to delete the two individuals from the electors list. Mr. Lovell seconded the motion. Ms. Krull, Ms. Sorohan, Mr. Lovell, and Mr. Webb voted in favor of the motion. Ms. Peck abstained. The motion carried.
- Resolved, that the voters are no longer qualified to be registered in Lumpkin County.
