

**LUMPKIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
PUBLIC HEARING NOTES**

September 20, 2016

CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairman Sherrill called the Public Hearing to order at 4:07 p.m. in the Boardroom of the Lumpkin County Administration Building. Present were Doug Sherrill, Rhett Stringer, and Bob Pullen. Absent were Chris Dockery and Steve Shaw was absent from the meeting.

PUBLIC HEARING

The purpose of this public hearing is to discuss the Lumpkin County Board of Commissioners tentative adoption of a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes over the rollback rate by 15.18 percent in Unincorporated Lumpkin County, 14.50 percent in Incorporated Lumpkin County, 3.89 percent in Unincorporated Lumpkin County Reservoir, and 7.36 percent in Unincorporated Lumpkin County Planning.

Vice Chairman Sherrill read aloud the purpose of the public hearing and the following paragraph.

All concerned citizens are invited to the three public hearings on this tax increase. The public hearings will be held September 13, 2016 at 6:00 p.m., September 15, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. and September 20, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. in the Boardroom of the Lumpkin County Administration Building, 99 Courthouse Hill, Dahlonega, Georgia.

Vice Chairman Sherrill asked for questions and comments from the public with only Ken Akins asking to be heard. He read aloud from a previously prepared, written statement.
