The purpose of this work session is to meet Lagala Fugate and Cheyenne Thornton. Lagala Fugate is nominated for Seat 3, with a term expiring June 30, 2016; Cheyenne Thornton is nominated for Seat 4, with a term expiring June 30, 2017 of the Lumpkin County Department of Family & Children's Services Board.


**ADJOURN**
