CALL TO ORDER

This is a renewal of the Winter Weather Road Treatment Assistance Agreement allowing Raines Grading and Hauling, LLC to haul gravel, sand, salt and other materials as may, from time to time, be identified by Lumpkin County, its agents and employees, from designated loading sites to designated distribution sites.

This is to replace the current provider (Gunby Communications) with Quality Recording Systems for maintenance of the E911 recorder.

Ninth District Opportunity Agreement – Use of Room by Lumpkin County Schools

This is to give written permission to Ninth District Opportunity for the Lumpkin County school system's preschool special education class to be located in one of the lower level classrooms of the J.B. Jones Preschool Building.

Motion: Commissioner Dockery moved to approve the letter of approval. The motion was seconded by Bob Pullen. Motion was approved by Commissioners Sherrill, Shaw, Stringer, and Pullen. The motion carried.

BMK Bid Proposal – Fire Station # 7 – Recommendation from Building Committee

This is to discuss the Building Committee recommendation for Fire Station #7.

Motion: A motion was made by Commissioner Sherrill to reject the bid which was seconded by Steve Shaw. That motion was approved by all district commissioners. The motion carried.

Motion: Commissioner Stringer made a motion to bid out a 60x60 butler style building, 2 bays, 16 ft. eave height, 14x14 ft. doors, insulated and electrical, 6 in. pad, propane hanging heater, and stubbed out for one bathroom. The motion was seconded by Bob Pullen. That motion was approved by all district commissioners and the motion carried.
