**Agenda Item:** City of Dawsonville & Lumpkin County Intergovernmental Agreement – Animal Control

**Item Description:** **Providing for specific services to the City of Dawsonville for housing of Dogs and Cats through their Animal Control Services**

**Facts & Historical Information:** During the years of operation of the Lumpkin County Animal Shelter, Lumpkin County Government has had one other Intergovernmental Agreement, this was with White County Government. This agreement was in place for approximately three years.

The city of Dawsonville has requested that Lumpkin County enter into an agreement to house approximately forty (40) animals per year for a per animal fee of forty-five dollar.

Under this IGA, all animals surrendered by the City of Dawsonville to the Lumpkin County Animal Shelter would be governed by all polices and guidelines of the Lumpkin County Animal Shelter.

**Potential Courses of Action:** A) Approve the IGA

B) Disapprove

**Budget Impact:** A) Charging the forty-five dollar per animal fee should mean that there will be no budget impact on the expenditure side of the shelter budget

B) No budget impact
