**Facts & Historical Information:**

In September, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) announced its 2015 Recreational Trails Grant Program applications would be available for download on October 13, 2015.

Projects eligible for funding include: trail and trailhead construction, trail maintenance, trail assessments/studies, and property acquisition for trail recreation facilities. Grants are awarded on a competitive basis. The minimum grant award is \$25,000.00. Projects that provide for non-motorized uses can receive a maximum grant award of \$100,000.00. Projects designed to accommodate off-road motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, or off-road four-wheel-drive trucks may propose a higher grant amount. Grant recipients must match 20% of the project cost.

**Potential Courses of Action:**

- A. Prepare and submit a Recreational Trails Grant Program application to construct a trail connecting the Yahoola Creek Park trail with the Yahoola Creek Reservoir trail.
- B. Take no action.

**Budget Impact:** The Recreational Trails Grant Program requires grant recipients to provide a match of not less than 20% of the project cost.


