ERECTION OF A METAL BUILDING

Lumpkin County Board of Commissioners is requesting sealed bids from qualified licensed vendors to erect a metal building. The building will be located on county owned property in the Frogtown community. The purpose of the building will be to house fire equipment and will be an unmanned structure. The County does not guarantee a minimum value for this contract.

Bidders are required to carefully examine the specifications contained in this bid document. Any deviation from specifications must be completely explained by the bidder in writing.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM, EST on April 1, 2016. The location of the conference will be in the First Floor Conference Room at the Lumpkin County Administrative Building, 99 Courthouse Hill, Dahlonega, Georgia, 30533.

All questions will be posted by addenda no later than 5:00 PM, EST on April 14, 2016.

Bids are due no later than 10:00 AM, EST on April 21, 2016, and may be delivered to the Lumpkin County Administrative Building at 99 Courthouse Hill, Suite D, and Dahlonega, Georgia 30533. The outside shipping container must be clearly marked with the appropriate bid number and title. Immediately following the deadline the names of the bidders will be recorded and read aloud in the First Floor Conference Room at the above address.

The bid documents and specifications are available for inspection at the Lumpkin County Purchasing Department, 99 Courthouse Hill, Suite D; Dahlonega, Georgia; phone 706-482-2655 or fax 706-482-2201 and on the County website, www.lumpkincounty.gov.

Bids may not be withdrawn for ninety (90) days after the time and date set for closing, except as allowed by OCGA. Lumpkin County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any technicalities, to waive any informality, to reject portions of the bid and to award contracts in a manner consistent with the interest of Lumpkin County and the laws of the State of Georgia.
